Truk Lagoon, also known as Chuck Lagoon, is a World War II shipwreck diving destination in Micronesia. It is located about 1,500 miles east of the Philippines and 500 miles north of New Guinea in the Pacific Ocean. The lagoon is home to over 60 shipwrecks, including Japanese warships, merchant ships, and airplanes.

Scuba Diving in True Lagoon is a unique and unforgettable experience. The wrecks are incredibly well-preserved, and the visibility is often excellent. Add to this the amazing marine life with soft and hard corals, schools of fish, sharks and rays. Truly a divers paradise.

The best way to dive Truk Lagoon is on a liveaboard. The best liveaboard in Truk Lagoon (perhaps the best liveaboard in the world) is the Odyssey.



The Odyssey is a 132 foot air-conditioned liveaboard vessel with spacious rooms, private ensuite facilities, and a large entertainment lounge. All meals and beverages are include.



With a great dive deck area, easy in and out of water access, Nitrox, this makes doing the 27 dives planned for the 7 day trip a breeze.



A Typical Dive Day Aboard the Odyssey - The day aboard Odyssey begins after a 7:00 a.m. hot breakfast with your first dive briefing around 7:45. You will be able to do two dives before lunch. During lunch we usually move to a new site. After lunch you have the option to either do another dive, or relax on the either of the sundecks or in the privacy of your own stateroom.

A late afternoon dive is also offered. Around 6:30 p.m. a sumptuous dinner will be waiting for you. After dinner you may choose to do a night dive. At night guests usually gather in the entertainment lounge to enjoy a movie, or review the pictures and videos captured that day.

Since most of the dive sites in Truk Lagoon are fairly close to each other, it is easy for us to move around. The best part about diving aboard Odyssey is that we don't require everyone to dive at the same time. So it is not unusual for you and your buddy to be the only divers on a 500' wreck. For photographers, this offers more opportunities to shoot those popular scenes without having to wait for others to move out of the way.

If the dates don't work for you, you can still enjoy this amazing trip. Ed Tiedemann, who has run the trip in the past, can set up a trip just for you (or you and your dive buddy). Normally getting the reservation time for this trip is very long. It took two years to set up the original trip. There often are spots or two available. We can find them and set something up. We even have a travel agent who can help you with your air arrangements. This costs you nothing extra.

Here are the pricing details for a trip we would set up for you, if you are unable to go on Mary's trip.

If you are interested in going in 2023 (if we can find you a spot) the cost is \$3,495 per person for double occupancy. Guaranteed single occupancy is a double occupancy room is \$5,095. If you want to go in 2024 the prices are \$3,495 and \$5,245. For 2025 the prices are \$3,695 and \$5,545. We even have pricing for 2026, which is \$3,795 and \$5,645. Remember this does not include airfare.
